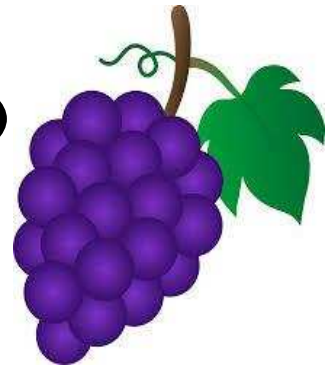

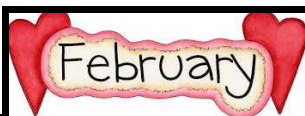

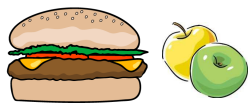
February 6th - 24th is our campaign
